

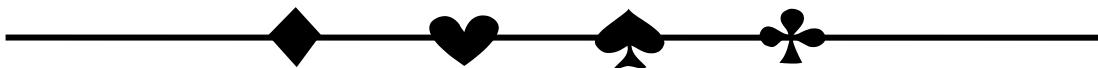

“BAD KEN’S SCARS FROM THE TRENCHES”.

Bad Ken and Lucky Lewis were mowing down the field. They played Lacy Linda and Terrible Trudy (both beginners) in the final round. Bad Ken was dealer with this hand--♠-x, ♥-Kx, ♦-A109x and ♣-A108764. Both sides were vulnerable. He opened the hand one ♣. Lacy Linda paused and bid two spades. Pass, pass came back to BK – D, since BK and LL played negative doubles. BK’s double ended the auction. BK and Lucky didn’t realize that Lacy didn’t know the meaning of a jump overcall. She later said to the director, called by BK as she wrapped up two spades doubled-- "I was planning to open two clubs and so I thought I would jump in spades to energize Terrible Trudy. Lacy’s hand was ♠-AKJ9x, ♥-AQx, ♦-Qx and ♣-KQx. Terrible Trudy’s only points were the KJ of ♦. BK scored up the minus 670 and turned in the ticket that cost BK and Lucky their victory. The director explained to BK and Lucky that the absence of information in the jump overcall section or any other section of the Convention Card meant that Lacy and Trudy had no agreement on the meaning of a jump overcall. Moral: Beware of blank spaces!!!

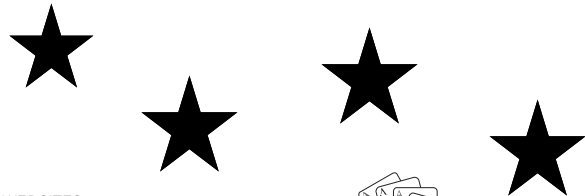

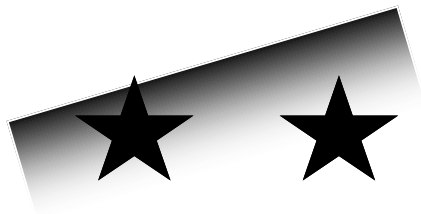
