Lessons By Barbara Feeley

Optimism: It's been said that an optimist counts the winners in a bridge hand while a pessimist counts the losers. Not true! What could be more fun for an optimist than eliminating a loser, or turning a loser into a winner?

Let's say that your contract is 3 Hearts (or 4 or 6, it does not matter; the principles are the same.) You have Qx of clubs and xxx (three small) of diamonds. This looks like 5 losers until we see in dummy a diamond void and AKx in clubs. Wow! We'll win the opening lead, trump a diamond, small club to the Q, trump another diamond, A of Clubs and King of clubs for a discard of the third diamond or a spade. We've eliminated all those losers with the good help of our partner's hand and the optimistic approach to playing a hand of bridge. The game is too much fun for pessimism!
