Happy New Year!

We have two tournaments in Tucson to start off the 2012! The Tucson Winter Sectional is January 5-8, 2012 at the Desert Diamond. The Tucson Old Pueblo Regional is February 27th through March 4th at The Holiday Inn Palo Verde. Please note there is a New Player (I/N) Schedule for players under 200 points at both of these tournaments. For those seeking gold points, Gold Rush Pairs on Friday March 2nd is a great opportunity. This new event has a masterpoint limit of 750. Gold points are awarded for a Section top (in either of the two sessions) or an overall ranking (after both sessions) in the "B" stratification. Gold points are also awarded to section tops in the Knockouts and Side Games (see explanation below). Please let me know if you need help finding a partner as soon as possible. Please see the flyer for each of these on our website or at your local club.

What are Side Games? The Side Game Series is always a multi-session event. Each session is a regular pair game, and awards are given for each individual session. In addition, there are overall awards for those who perform best during the various sessions. Each individual receives credit for his/her best two scores, and the overall ranking is done from these figures. Each player may play with as many different partners as there are sessions since the overall standings are determined on an individual basis. The series must consist of three or more sessions. At North American Bridge Championships, session awards are paid in red points, but overall awards incorporating the scores from all sessions are paid in gold points. Masterpoint awards are based on the formula for a two-session open event. (Quoted from ACBL website).

The Unit Game this month is Sunday, January 15th at Las Candelas Bridge Club. Snacks are served prior to the beginning of the game at 1 PM. Please call Las Candelas (696-9101) to make your reservation. If you need a partner please let me know. Remember there are extra black points awarded for this game!

BRIDGE BITES from The American Contract Bridge League

An Old Ruse
by Brian Gunnell

Here's a neat deception, but, alas, it won't work against modern signaling methods.

None Vulnerable

Against 3NT West leads his 4th-best Spade. East's Jack is taken by Declarer's Queen, then a Diamond to Dummy and the losing Club finesse. At this point West can count 9 or 10 tricks for Declarer, via 2 Spades, 4 Diamonds and 3 or 4 Clubs. West's only hope for defeating 3NT is that the defense can cash 4 Hearts. Bingo! He shifts to a low Heart and it's down one.

Take Two! West leads a low Spade, as before, but this time Declarer wins East's Jack with the Ace! Yes, really! Declarer doesn't need a second Spade trick, but he does want to avoid a Heart shift and that extravagance in the Spade suit is just the way to do it. Later, when West wins his ♣K, he's likely to be duped into assuming that East has the ♠Q and will lead another low Spade. 10 tricks!

The Antidote! Twenty or thirty years ago, this sneaky ruse worked every time, but nowadays there is a defensive antidote. It involves East telling partner whether or not he likes that opening Spade lead. When Declarer leads a Diamond at Trick 2, East can signal with the Nine (high means "I like your opening lead"), or with the Six (low means "I don't"). On the actual deal, East plays the discouraging Six, alerting West to Declarer's shenanigans. That signal is called a Smith Echo and is a common agreement among tournament players. For more on this, please Google "smith echo for dummies". No offense, dear readers, it's merely a search which takes you to a most helpful article.
