- 3. Education: Adair reported that she is looking for local players for speakers at the coming NLM tournaments, and looking for players in the Phoenix area for Regionals.
- 4. I/N Representative: Jo Ann showed us fliers from ACBL for new players. She has made them available at the local clubs. She requested that we try to have a NLM Swiss Team game in July. Christie said it would need to fit into the calendar to determine if it can be worked out.
